Workplace Litigation and Dispute Resolution Certificate Program

It is now possible for students who cannot decide between the LADR and the Labor and Employment certificate programs to enroll in the Workplace Litigation and Dispute Resolution Certificate Program.

All students admitted into the Workplace Litigation and Dispute Resolution Certificate Program who receive a J.D. Degree will also receive a Certificate if they successfully complete the following course requirements:

A. Required Courses

- 1. Labor Law 4 credits
- 2. Employment Relationships..... 3 credits
- 3. Evidence 3 credits
- 4. Legal Writing IV for Labor and Employment..... 3 credits
- 5. One seminar in a Labor and Employment related topic... 2 credits
- 6. Either Pretrial Litigation OR Employment Litigation 3 credits
- 7. Mediation & ADR Clinic OR the ADR in the Workplace intensive intersession course..... 2 – 4 credits

B. Plus two of the Following

- 1. Employment Discrimination..... 3 credits
- 2. Labor or Employment Law Externship..... 4 credits
- 3. In-house Plaintiffs Employment Law Clinic or Civil Litigation Clinic 3 or 4 credits
- 4. Trial Ad 1..... 3 credits
