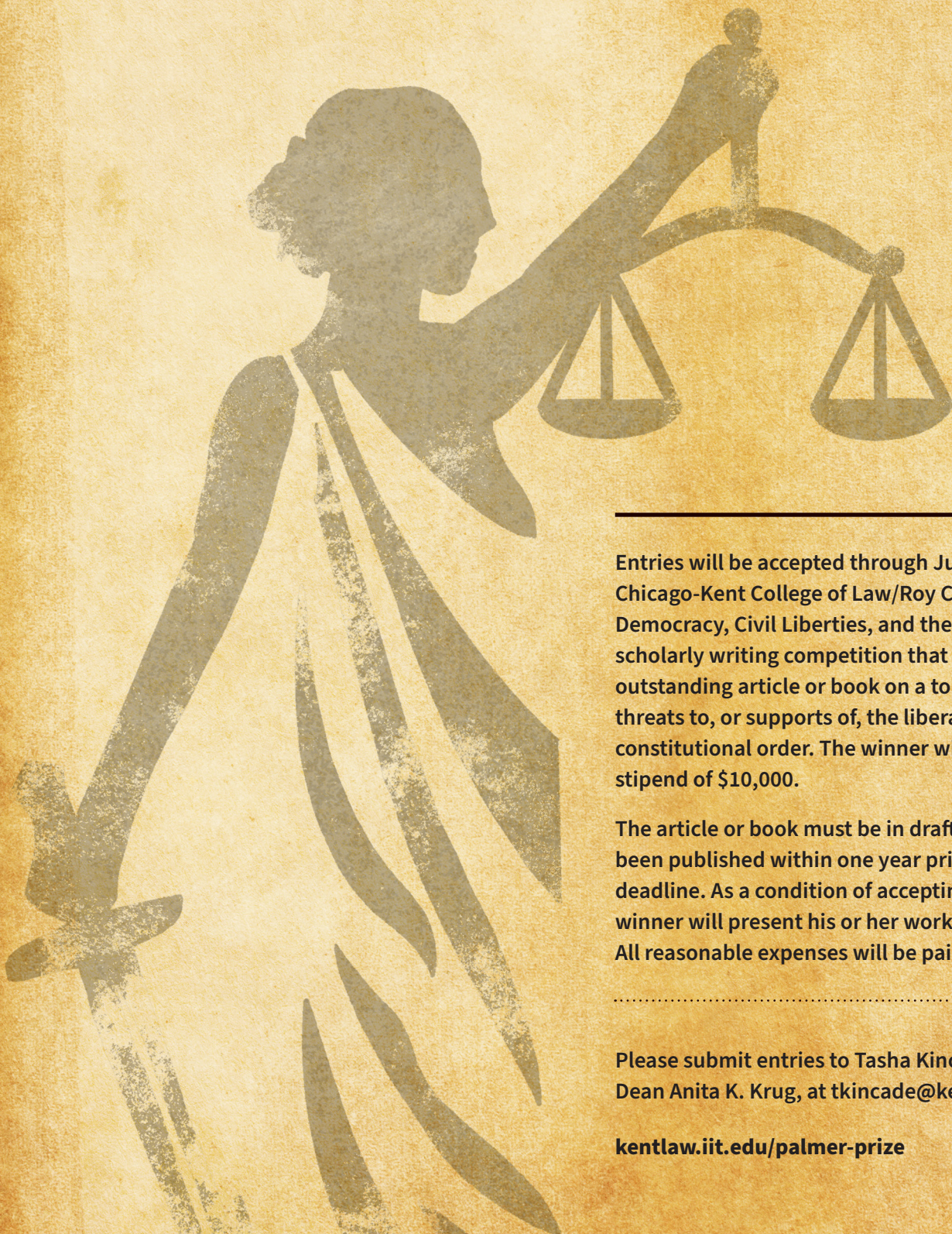


2022 Chicago-Kent College of Law Roy C. Palmer Civil Liberties Prize



Entries will be accepted through July 1, for the Chicago-Kent College of Law/Roy C. Palmer Prize on Democracy, Civil Liberties, and the Rule of Law, a scholarly writing competition that honors an outstanding article or book on a topic exploring threats to, or supports of, the liberal democratic constitutional order. The winner will receive a cash stipend of \$10,000.

The article or book must be in draft form or have been published within one year prior to the July 1 deadline. As a condition of accepting the award, the winner will present his or her work at Chicago-Kent. All reasonable expenses will be paid.
